News for Veterans

The Senior Veteran Homeless Population is expected to triple in the next decade, and in November, the United Way of the Midlands; Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska Department of Veterans Affairs and community partners joined to launch the Military and Family Helpline, marking a significant step forward in support of military-connected individuals and their families.

The NDVA awarded grant funding to the innovative collaboration that seeks to strengthen support for veterans and active-duty military, and their dependents by leveraging existing community resources and infrastructure.

Of the 100,000 veterans in Nebraska, 60 percent of active-duty service mem-

bers and their families live off-base. For them, confidentiality, convenience and complexity are often cited as barriers to accessing programs or services.

The 211 Helpline serves as a vital resource, offering comprehensive and confidential assistance to those seeking access to a wide range of community support services.

The Military and Family Helpline provides tailored support to veterans, retirees, service members, civilian personnel and their families statewide in Nebraska and Iowa.

As part of a signed partnership agreement with Offutt AFB, a navigator will maintain offices on base and at UWM building in the Millwork Commons to help families.
